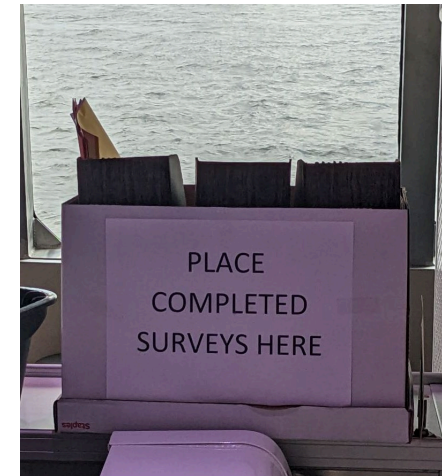
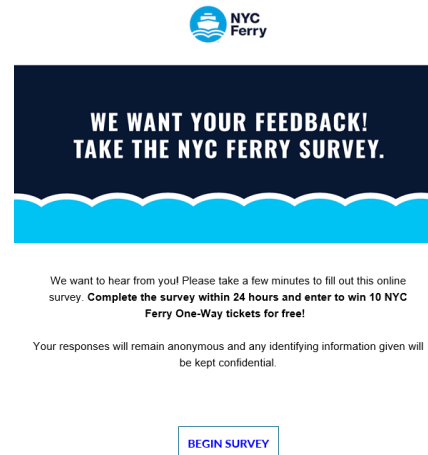
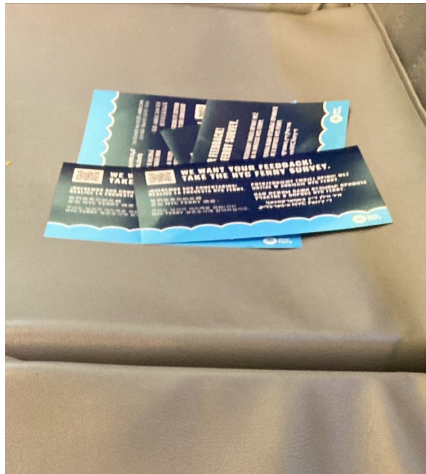
2022 Survey Overview

2022 Survey Methodology

The 2022 survey was distributed via 3 methods:

- **On-Board QR Codes:** QR codes were available via postcards on seats and digital ads. 771 responses were received via on-board QR code.
- **Email to recent riders:** Email was sent to all riders who activated a ticket within an hour of app ticket activation. 830 responses were received via email link.
- **Paper Surveys:** Paper surveys were available on all NYCF vessels in seven languages. 22 responses were received via paper surveys.

95% of survey respondents indicated they use the NYCF app.



Survey 2022 Methodology

Language: Survey was available in English, Spanish, Chinese, Korean, Polish, Russian, and Yiddish.

Survey Period: Survey was open for 14 days: Monday, Aug. 29 – Sunday, Sep. 11

8 Routes: Astoria, East River, Governors Island, Rockaway, Rockaway Rocket, Soundview, South Brooklyn, St. George.

Responses Received: ~1,600 (average of 81 per route/time period bin), weighted based on actual observed ridership during survey period. Rockaway Rocket and Governors Island, which operated on weekends only, had lower response rates. They are included in systemwide measures, but not broken down at the route level.

New Questions: This survey added questions on:

- Commuting frequency
- Disability status
- Smartphone ownership/app usage
- Bikes, strollers, wheelchairs, and other items brought on board

Purpose: Customer segmentation & demographic information; trip purpose and NYC Ferry usage patterns

Survey Weighting

Since 2019, NYC Ferry weights survey results based on actual observed ridership during the survey period. This helps ensure that totals and percentages are reflective of actual demographics and ridership, rather than survey response rate.

1. Collect survey data and prepare for analysis
2. Categorize responses by both route and time of day. Time period categories are below:
 - Peak (Weekdays before 10AM, between 4PM & 7PM)
 - Off-Peak (Weekdays between 10AM & 4PM, Weekdays after 7PM)
 - Weekend (All times on Saturday/Sunday)
3. Separate actual ridership during the survey period into the same route/time period buckets as the survey results
4. Calculate weighted value using following formula for each route/time period bucket:
 - $(\text{Total Observed Ridership in Bucket}) / (\text{Total Survey Respondents})$
 - This weighted value is used so that when survey responses are summed, they are equal to the actual ridership on that route/time period

Summary of Results

The results of the 2022 survey remained consistent with previous surveys, but trip purpose and frequency continue to be impacted by COVID-19 and demonstrate slower return to office rates among workers.

Consistent with Previous Results

- Systemwide Median Income is \$100,000-\$149,999
- A majority (66%) of riders walked to and from their ferry landing
- 90% of riders are NYC residents

Changes from Previous Surveys

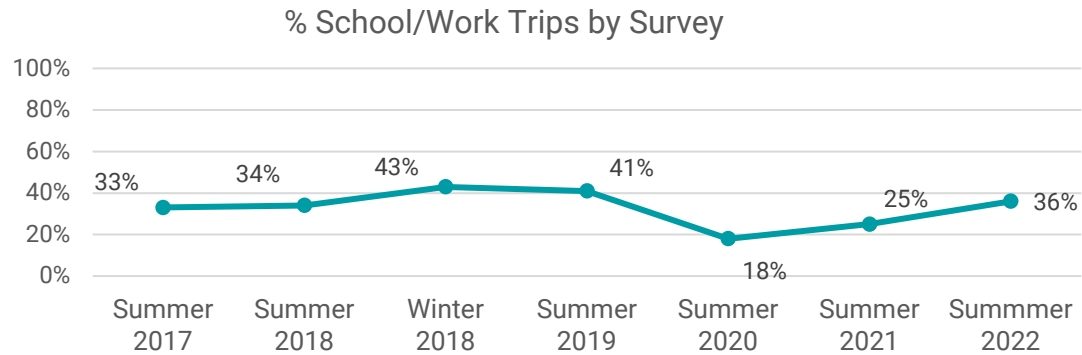
- 38% of ridership identified as non-white, highest level since launch, and 7% higher than in 2021
- 61% of peak riders were using the service to commute to work or school, rising since 2021 but still 10% below pre-pandemic levels
- 56% of riders ride the ferry 3 or more days a week, rising since 2021 but still below pre-pandemic levels
- 36% of all riders are going to/from work or school, the highest number since 2019 and closer to the national average pre-pandemic ([49%](#))

2022 Survey – Travel Patterns

Trip purpose by route and time period

61% of peak period riders were commuting to work or school. During all time periods, 36% of riders were commuting to work or school.

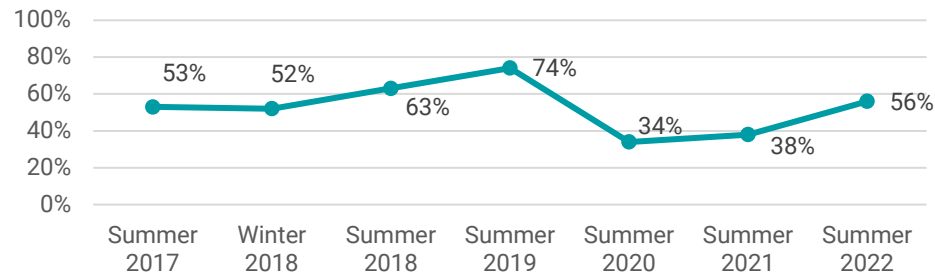
This is higher than 2020 and 2021 surveys, but still lower than in 2019.

Trip frequency

56% of peak riders use the ferry at least 3 days per week.








































% Peak Frequent Riders by Survey



Peak rider frequency was **lower** than 2019, but in line with 2017 and 2018 surveys. Increased frequency demonstrates some recovery to pre-COVID travel patterns.

Frequency of Commuting

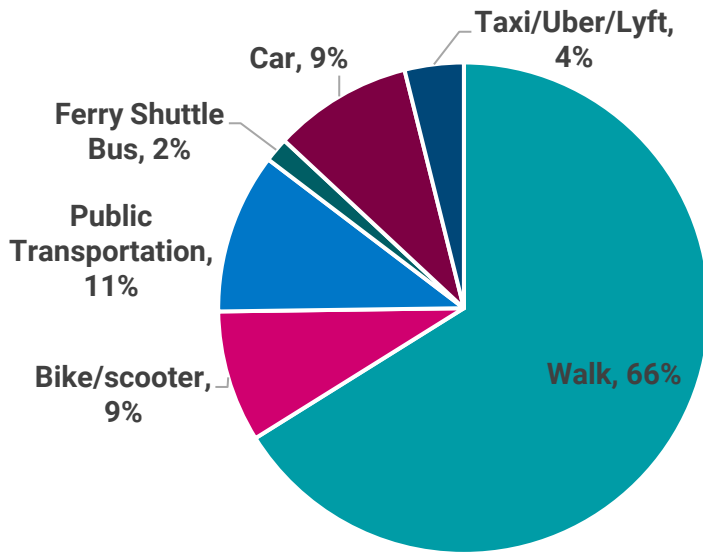
63% of all riders indicated they have used NYC Ferry to get to work at least once. 89% of weekday morning riders indicated they used NYC Ferry to get to work at least once a week.

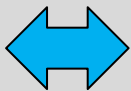
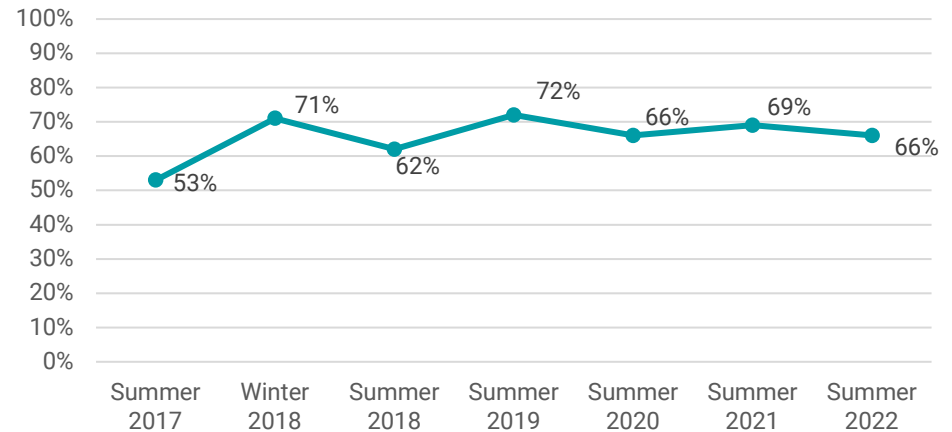
This is the first time NYC Ferry asked this question.

Mode to/from landings

66% of riders walked to or from the ferry. An additional 9% scooter or bike. 11% use other public transportation services, and 9% use an automobile to access NYC Ferry. Bay Ridge, Ferry Point Park, Rockaway, and Soundview account for most drivers. Public transit use is highest at East 34th Street and Wall Street/Pier 11.



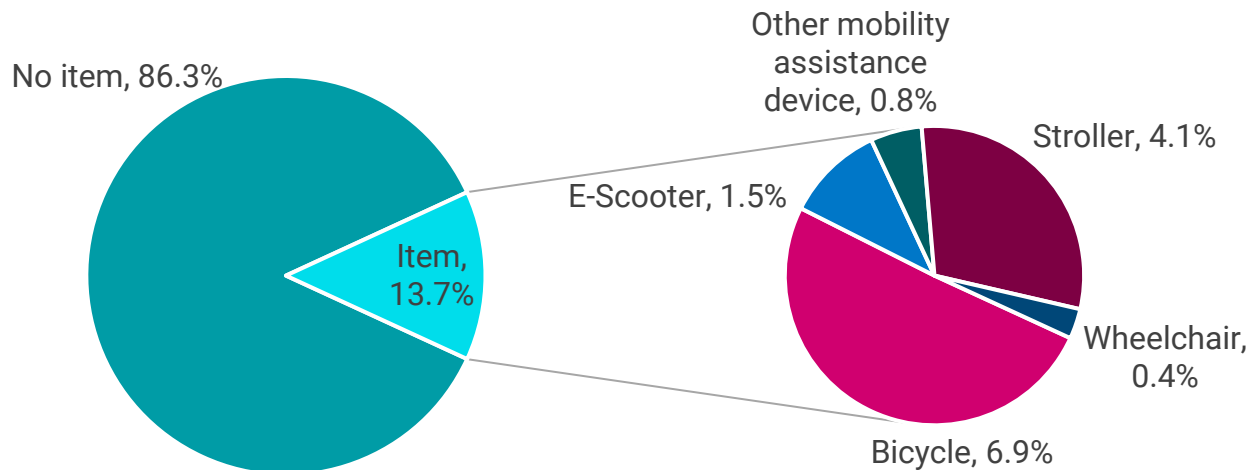
% Walk to and from NYC Ferry Landing by Survey

Mobility Devices On-Board

14% of riders brought a mobility device on-board. The most common items were bicycles (7%) and strollers (4%). Bikes were most common on [Rockaway](#).

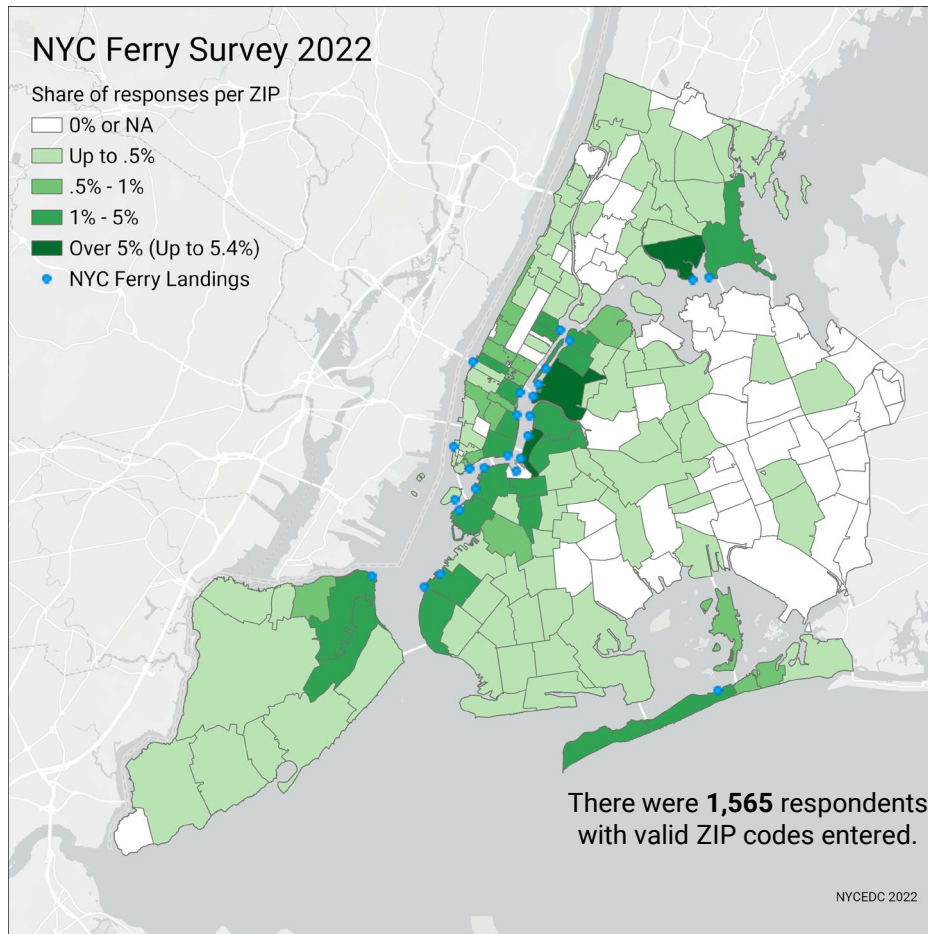


This is the first time this question has been asked.

2022 Survey – Demographic Data

All routes – home ZIP codes

90% of riders reside within New York City. This year, the share of riders from **Ferry Point Park's** zip has nearly doubled since 2021.

Age & Disability Status

13% of riders are over the age of 65. 16% of riders self-identified as having a disability. These riders may be eligible to apply for a \$1.35 fare under the Ferry Discount Program.

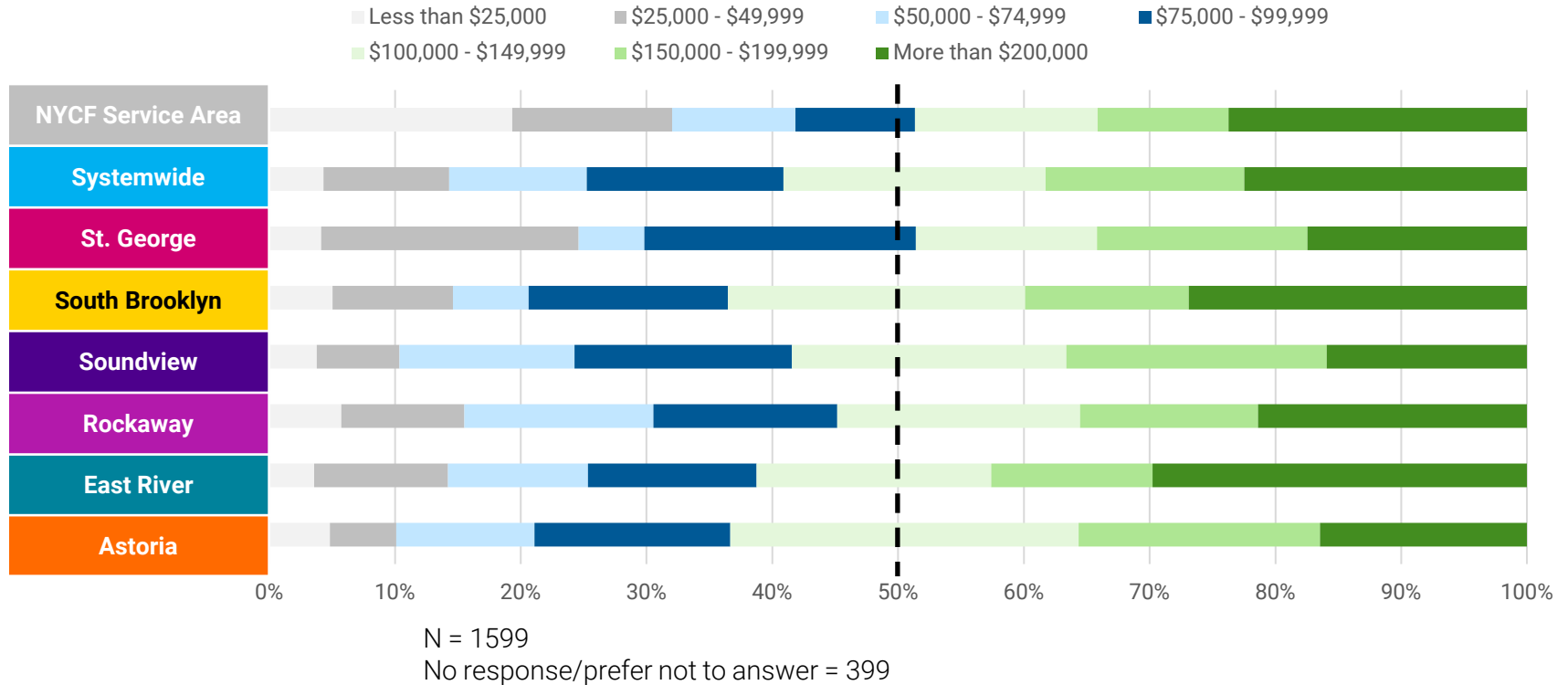

Annual Household Income

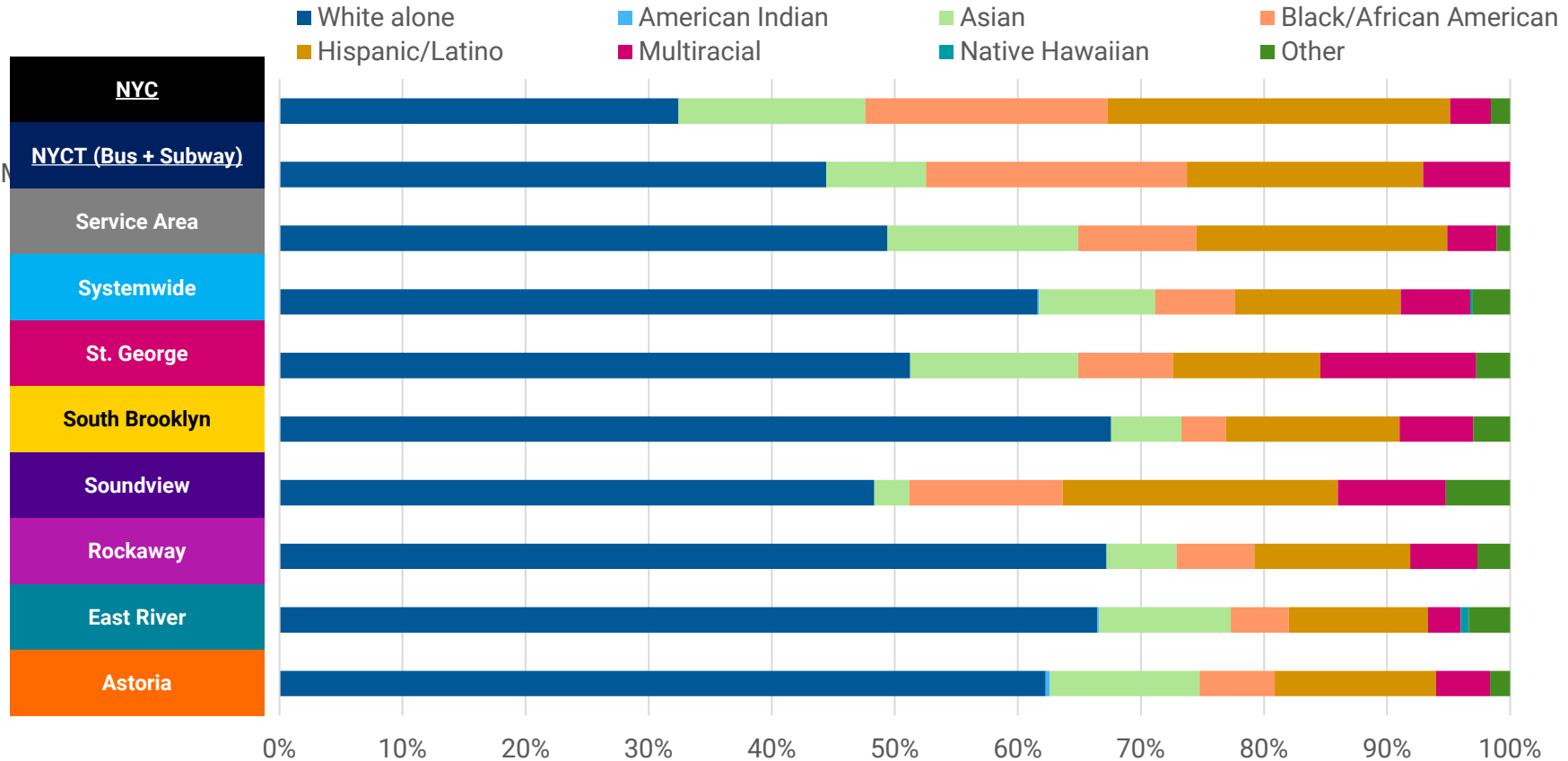
The systemwide median annual household income is \$100,000-149,999, an increase from 2019 and 2020 but in line with 2017, 2018, and 2021. Per the US Census Bureau's 2016-2020 ACS estimates, the median household income for all routes is \$98,747.



This is in-line with previous surveys. NYCF's Service Area is defined as all Census Tracts within a .5 mile radius of an NYCF landing.

Race/Ethnicity by Route

System-wide, 38% of riders identified as non-white or multiracial. In NYCF's service area, 51% of riders identified as non-white or multiracial



Percentage of non-white riders is **higher** than previous surveys for the system.
