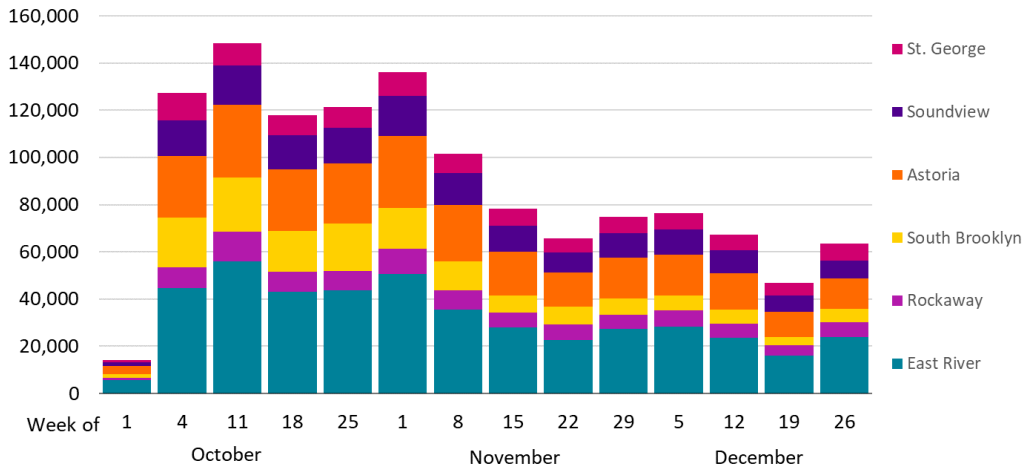

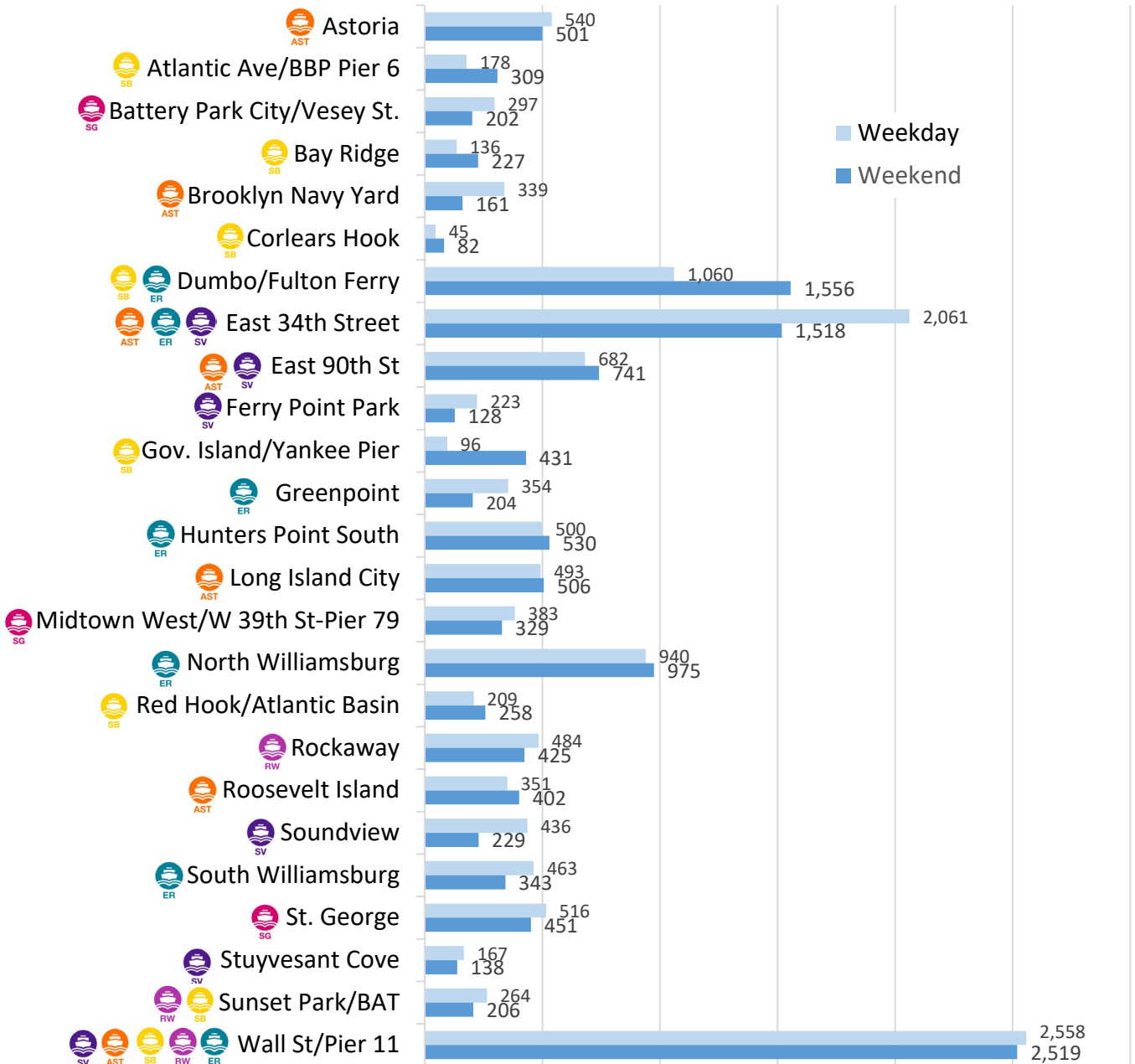

Service Notes

At year-end, annual ridership was over 6 million for the first time since 2019. Greenpoint, which re-opened in November, carried over 340 daily weekday riders. Astoria, Soundview, and St. George had their highest ridership years in 2022.

NYC Ferry operated a holiday schedule on 10/12-10/13 for Sukkot. Holiday schedules were also operated on 11/25 and 12/25. The Greenpoint landing re-opened on 11/14. The winter schedule went into effect on 11/7. Governors Island landing closed for planned maintenance on 12/19 and remained closed through end of year.

¹On Time Performance is calculated as the percentage of trips that departed no more than 1 minute before and arrive no more than 5 minutes past their scheduled times at each landing. This report does not include delays due to events outside of the control of NYC Ferry, such as vessel traffic, river closures/obstructions, extreme weather conditions, and other U.S. Coast Guard restrictions. When tracking devices are offline, the stops are excluded from the calculation. ²Number of NYCF-branded vessels available for use.
